WHEREAS Senate Bill 150 and Assembly Bill 160 would alter the way that segregated fees are charged to students, making them charged on a per credit basis; and

WHEREAS this change could result in a significant loss in segregated fee funding and would place a greater financial burden on certain student populations at UWL; and

WHEREAS many students who have less than 12 credits utilize segregated fee funded resources at the same rate or more than those with 12 or more credits; and


WHEREAS the authors of the bills did not directly reach out to UWL Student Association to gain input from students who represent our campus; and

WHEREAS there has not been enough outreach to and discussion with students who will be affected by these bills; and

WHEREAS the Board of Regents and UW System specialize in policies and regulations regarding higher education, and should determine any changes within this policy area;


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the UWL Student Association opposes Senate Bill 150 and Assembly Bill 160; and
