SkyTrain Canada Line light rail goes from the airport to downtown ("Waterfront" station) in 25 minutes, \$8.75 before 6:30 pm, \$7.50 after 6:30 pm.

It's a short walk not far beyond the taxi stand, and there are clear signs.

[Google Transit goofed, suggesting I walk 600 meters east to the next Skytrain station, as did the local Translink trip planning option.]

Taxis are regulated, and about CAN\$30 before tip.

The Compass card kiosks at all Skytrain station entrances take Visa or Mastercard (including from U.S.) or Canadian cash. The cards can be refilled on the web.

The public bus system also uses the Compass card. Most bus and SkyTrain

trips not involving the airport are \$2.75 each. From downtown back to the

airport on the weekend by SkyTrain is also \$2.75.

The Sheraton Vancouver Wall Centre is a 1.0 km walk north from "Yaletown-Roundhouse" station, or a 0.8 km walk west from "Vancouver City

Centre" station. I attach a map.
