Dear UWL Students (cc: UWL Personnel),

If you are a student experiencing exceptional financial need arising from the COVID-19 pandemic, you may be eligible for a financial aid grant made possible through the recently authorized Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund II (HEERF II).

All degree seeking students, currently enrolled this spring in at least half-time enrollment (6 credits undergraduate; 5 credits graduate), are eligible to apply. Students must also demonstrate eligibility for Federal financial aid by completing the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid).

Students who received the Federal Pell Grant this spring have automatically been awarded this emergency grant to ensure assistance to those most in need. This award is already in WINGS and you do not need to apply.

For those not receiving the Pell grant, to request financial support in the form of a one-time \$800 grant, please complete the application at https://uwlax.ca1.qualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV_cU7MQhtE4kSnJ4O Upon submission, a decision will be made based on the funding available and the eligibility criteria. A member of the Financial Aid Office team will be in touch with applicants within a few business days of submitting the application. All eligible applications will be considered, and the grants will be awarded on a first-come first-served basis until the funding is exhausted.
