1. **Community-based vaccination clinic at UWL.** (Cleary Alumni Center, 615 East Ave.) Register at vaccinate.wi.gov. Those registered will receive an email when vaccine appointments become available.
2. **Local pharmacies** ([Walgreens](#) or [Wal-Mart](#)).
3. **Gundersen Health System:** Patients eligible for vaccination will be contacted by letter, phone call, or through MyChart.
4. **Mayo Health System:** Patients eligible for vaccination will be contacted by letter, phone call, or through Patient Online Services.
