Subject: Return to Campus Update

Dear Campus Residents,

Thank you for your continued patience as we share our return to campus plan. As noted by Chancellor Gow, we are transitioning from the “shelter in place” to an “Eagles Return Safely” plan. Please read the below information for details. Your immediate assistance is essential.

If you have yet to do so, we need you to [complete this survey](#) to share where you are currently sheltering in place.

Students who are sheltering at another location:

In order to move back into your campus room, you are **required** to be approved to enter the halls by either signing up for a time to be tested or provide documentation of previous test results (as outlined below).

- All students who are currently sheltering in place away from campus should **not** return to campus before Monday, September 28 **and** must not return before their selected sign up time. No one is approved to return before Monday.
- [Sign up for a time here](#). Timeslots are available from Monday-Friday 8 a.m.- 3:30 p.m. in Cartwright Center ([#13 on the campus map](#)). (There is no testing available on the weekend.)
- This is a first come, first serve basis as we will test approximately 300 residents per day.
 - Test Results should be received within 1-2 hours of testing. Once you receive a negative test, you are able to enter your residence hall.
 - If isolation rooms are available COVID positive students may be assigned to them; otherwise they will need to (or may choose to) go home for isolation.
- If you have already been tested:
 - Bring documentation of a negative test result from an accredited health care provider or county health department dated within 48 hours of the established return date.
 - Bring documentation of a positive test result from an accredited health care provider or county health department dated within 90 days of the established return date.
 - Documentation can be verified in the following ways:
 - Documentation can be sent as an attachment to mmaloney-wang@uwlax.edu or faxed to 608.785.8746. You must go to the Office of Residence Life (Eagle Hall) between 8 a.m.- 5 p.m. to retrieve a wristband upon return to campus.
 - Bring physical documentation to the Office of Residence Life (Eagle Hall) between 8 a.m.- 5 p.m. for verification and to receive a wristband.

As a reminder, this week (September 21-25) we are testing all students who are sheltering ON campus, you need:

- If you have not yet done so, [Sign up for a time slot](#) for your **required** antigen test.
- Timeslots are available from 8 a.m.- 3:30 p.m. in Cartwright Center ([#13 on the campus map](#)).
- If you have already been tested:
 - Bring documentation of a negative test result from an accredited health care provider or county health department dated within 48 hours of the established return date.
 - Bring documentation of a positive test result from an accredited health care provider or county health department dated within 90 days of the established return date.
 - Documentation can be verified by sending an attachment to mmaloney-wang@uwlax.edu or faxed to 608.785.8746.

All residential students **must comply** with testing protocols and our return plan. Any refusal to do so will jeopardize your housing contract and may result in your status as a student to be reviewed.

Residence Life will continue to honor requests for housing contract cancellations. To start this process, complete the cancellation application: www.uwlax.edu/reslife/apply-for-housing/housing-contract/#tab-contract-cancellation. At this time, there is no deadline for students to submit a cancellation request.
