Greetings UWL students, faculty and staff,

The UWL Executive Policy Group is grateful for your attention to these updates regarding our campus COVID response. In preparation for the return of students, which will start to ramp-up next week, we will be implementing these two changes:

Effective Wednesday 8/4, face coverings are expected indoors for employees, students and guests, regardless of vaccination status.

- In all hallways, public spaces, common areas and classrooms at all times.
- In shared offices, shops, conference rooms and lab spaces.
- When traveling in a vehicle with more than one person.
- Masks should be worn correctly covering the mouth and nostrils.
- Masks may be removed in private offices, but should be worn anytime another person is in the room.
- Masks are not expected to be worn outdoors.

Plexiglass will be reinstalled around campus. This work started yesterday, and will continue throughout the week.

We continue to be pleased with the information coming in about the vaccination status of our campus community. **Students, if you have been vaccinated, please let us know**. If you have not yet been fully vaccinated, we encourage you to do so. Not only is this information immensely helpful in our planning discussions, you will also enter your name into a drawing for prizes and scholarships!
