Dear Students & Instructors, (cc: UWL staff)

As UWL heads into the last part of the semester, we are getting some questions about classrooms and instruction. Namely, we are being asked about the recommendation to quarantine for 14 days prior to any planned travel. Now that UWL courses will be online/remote after Thanksgiving, we know that some students will be returning home at Thanksgiving time and remaining home. Some of you are indicating a desire to not attend class for the next two weeks as part of a quarantine in preparation for the transition.

The safety protocols in place in the classrooms place class experiences at very low viral risk and attending class can be considered a part of a good risk reduction option for those planning on traveling. The goal of quarantining is to reduce the spread of the virus or access to the virus. If you are quarantining because you have tested positive, have a known exposure, and/or been advised to be a contact tracer, you should not be attending classes.
