HERE'S WHAT YOU DO:

- Briefly announce to your course(s) that you will be using the PRO system in EAB Navigate to send feedback
- o One way to state this to your class: *"This class participates in PRO (Progress Reports Online), you may receive an email stating you have received feedback; that feedback is from me and helps you to know how you're progressing in the course. In addition, you may receive follow up from your advisor based on the feedback you receive."*
- Look for an email link, which will allow you to provide information regarding student progress in your courses **by the end of next week**
- Fill out the form for appropriate students
- Reminder: the course withdrawal deadline is [Redacted]

Feedback is encouraged for all students, but we especially encourage you to complete the feedback form on students with whom you have academic concerns. The system is designed with check boxes to save time; however, we hope you provide commentary to illuminate your remarks.
