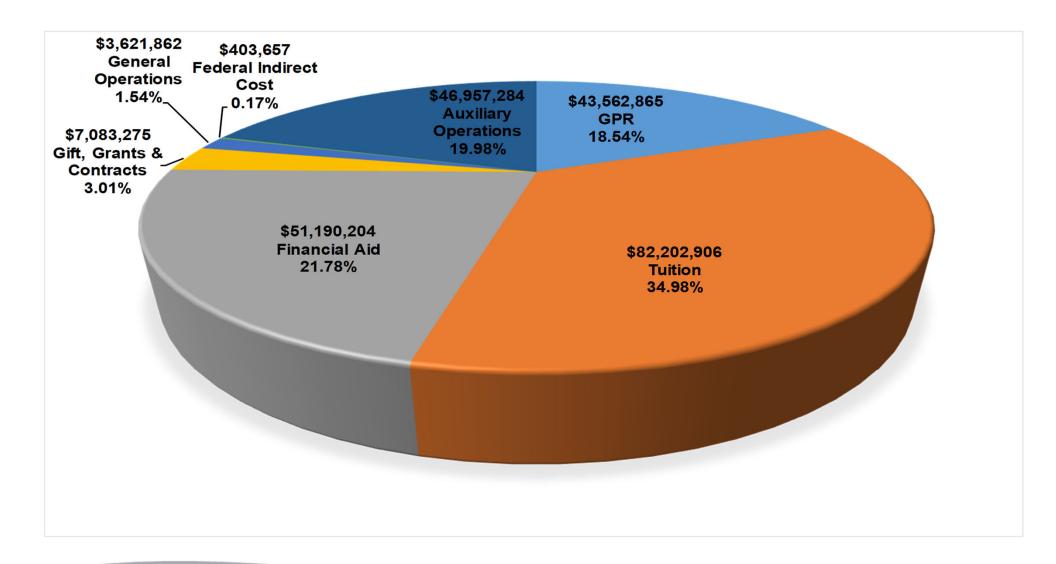

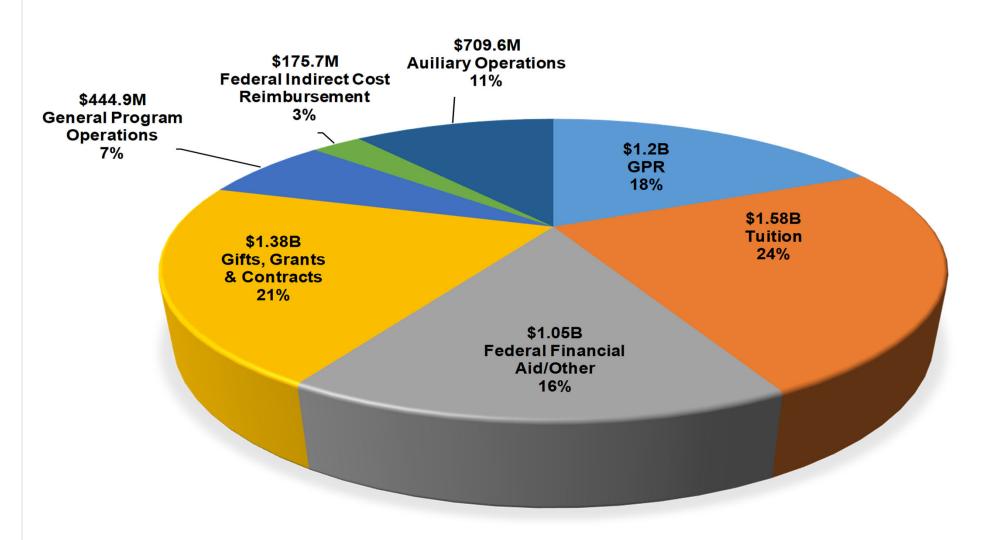

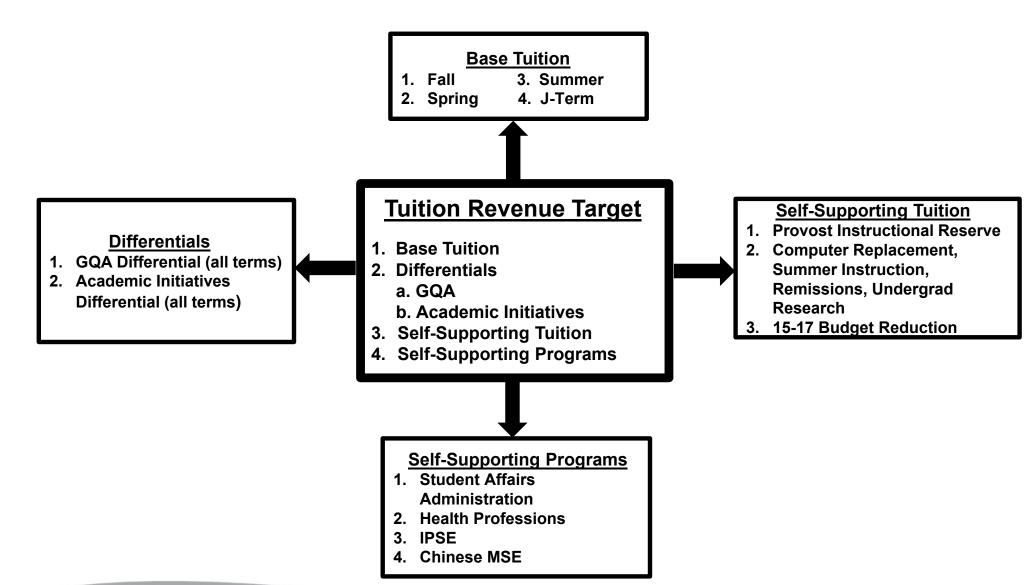

- Growth, Quality & Access Proposal 2007-08

 - 2 Year Phase-In
 - 75 Faculty & 20 Staff

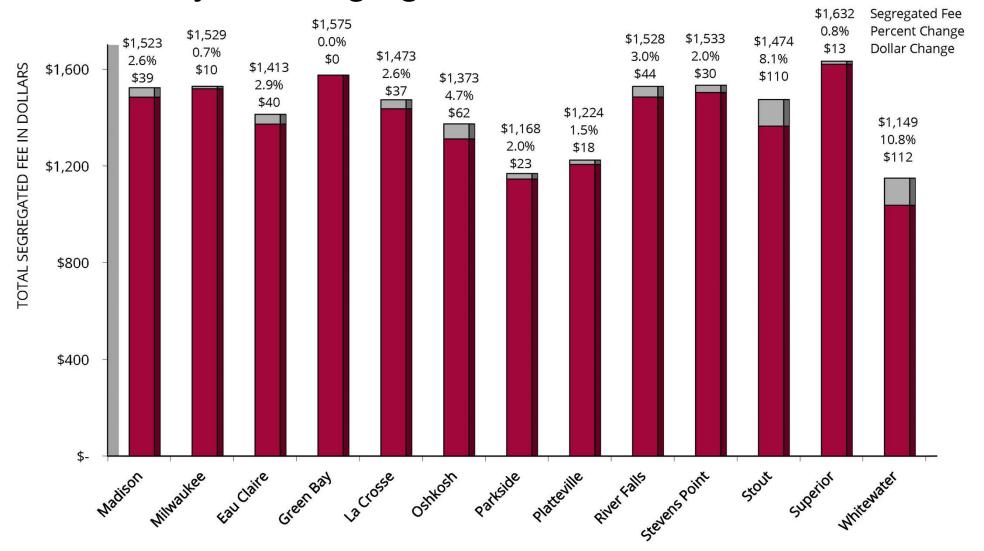
