## How To Use The Transfer Guide

In accordance with the UW System transfer policy, UWL can accept up to a **maximum of 72 credits** from the Wisconsin Technical College System institutions without first having earned an associate degree.

### **Program to Program Agreements:**

### **General Education Program Course Requirements:**
