## Transfer Student Admission Information **NEXT STEPS!**



### REGARDING YOUR LETTER OF ADMISSION

Your admission has been granted based on your past academic record and any courses in progress this year. **Final admission is contingent upon receipt of updated transcripts:**

- By January 30:** Official transcript with fall 2021 grades and spring 2022 courses in progress
- By July 1:** Final official transcript with spring 2022 grades

*If you are also taking summer session courses elsewhere, we must receive an official transcript with spring semester grades by July 1 and a final official transcript with summer session grades by August 28.*

#### **PLEASE NOTE:**

**Final transcripts will be reviewed to check grades. Poor academic performance may result in your admission being rescinded.**

If you have an established grade point average, it is our expectation that you will maintain this grade point average. If you are in your first semester of courses, it is our expectation that you will earn at least at 2.25 grade point average.

Certain undergraduate programs are highly selective and applicants must meet additional requirements for entrance into a program. Your letter of admission does not guarantee admission into any program of study.

### TRANSFER CREDIT REPORT

We will notify you via email when your transfer credit report is complete and direct you to your WINGS Student Center to view it.

NOTE: Criteria such as number of schools attended and/or number of credits earned may extend time necessary to complete your transfer credit report.

### WINGS STUDENT CENTER (<https://wings.uwlax.edu>)

Shortly after you applied for admission you received an email from the UW-La Crosse Admissions Office which contained information about your NetID/WINGS username and password. This information will allow you to log into your WINGS Student Center where you can track the status of your application.

- Update personal information
- View your financial aid package
- View your transfer credit report
- Register for classes and view class schedules
- Access communications

## ADDITIONAL STEPS THAT MAY APPLY TO YOU

### Take placement exams

Your eligibility to enroll in an English and/or mathematics course is determined by your scores and/or completion of certain college level coursework. ### Apply for on-campus housing

You can apply for on-campus housing at [www.uwlax.edu/reslife/apply-for-housing/application-process](http://www.uwlax.edu/reslife/apply-for-housing/application-process). A \$150 housing deposit is required as part of the housing application process. The \$150 housing deposit is refundable until May 1. If you would like to live on campus, please complete your housing application as soon as possible. Housing assignments are prioritized based on the day your housing application is completed. If you complete a housing application, you are guaranteed a place on campus. Do not sign an off campus lease if you have already completed a housing application.

### Explore off-campus housing

The University does not own any off-campus housing. You would work through an independent landlord or rental company to find a house or apartment to rent off-campus. ### Apply for financial aid

The 2022-2023 FAFSA application is available online after October 1, 2021 at [www.studentaid.gov](http://www.studentaid.gov). The **Federal School code for UWL is 003919**. You will need your completed Federal Income Tax information in order to complete the FAFSA. It is recommended that families use the "IRS Data Retrieval Option" when completing the income information sections of the FAFSA online. UWL's priority date is February 1 for consideration of all types of aid; however, applications are accepted throughout the academic year.

You can utilize the Financial Aid Calculator to estimate the amount of financial aid you might receive.

### Send AP, CLEP, or IB scores to Admissions

If you have taken Advanced Placement (AP) or CLEP exams, please contact The College Board at 888.225.5427 to request that official scores be sent to our office for evaluation. If you have taken IB exams, please refer to the International Baccalaureate website at [www.ibo.org](http://www.ibo.org) to request official scores. ### Submit disability related service requests

### Request military transcripts

Students at UWL may earn credit for the completion of basic training and advanced individual training. Military service school credit may be granted based upon recommendations of the American Council on Education. Generally, we accept credit for baccalaureate courses. Credit for military coursework beyond advanced individual training will not be accepted.

The Joint Services Transcript (JST) or the Community College of the Air Force (CCAF) are the basic documents used to evaluate transfer credits.

- **Army/Navy/Marine Corps/Coast Guard:** To request an official copy of your transcript, please visit the JST site.
- **Air Force** enlisted personnel will continue to receive their official professional military education transcript from the CCAF.

### Schedule an advising appointment

In April you will receive information about advising and registration. You will not meet with an Admissions Office staff member for advising, rather with an academic advisor from the College you are assigned (see your admission letter if you are unsure).
