- * Students who withdraw after the start of classes are charged a \$50.00 withdrawal fee.
- * Special Course Fees are non refundable after the 100% adjustment period unless indicated in the UW-L Course Catalog.
- * \$25.00 Non Refundable Registration Fee is charged each term.
