Academic Dress

The academic apparel worn by faculty and staff in the processional has its origins in the universities of the Middle Ages. Because the universities grew out of church schools, both faculty and students were regarded as part of the clergy and wore clerical clothing based on monastic dress.

The head covering developed from the skull cap worn to protect tonsured heads in cold weather. In the universities, the skull cap acquired a point at the top which gradually evolved into a tassel. In Europe, the bonnet with a tassel is still worn, but has been replaced in America by the mortar board cap or tam with a tassel.

The style of the gown may have been borrowed from the Benedictine monk's habit. In the Middle Ages, those with bachelor's and master's degrees could be distinguished by the simplicity or elaborateness of their gowns. The master's gowns were often furred, a decoration surviving as the three velvet bars now used on the sleeves of the doctoral gown.

The hood was originally worn over the head in bad weather, and otherwise dropped onto the shoulders. First worn by faculty and students, the hood is now added to the apparel of those with master's and doctoral degrees. The color of the velvet trim on the hood indicates the scholarly field, for example, dark blue (philosophy), golden yellow (science), light blue (education), pink (music), apricot (nursing), drab (business), and white (arts). The colors of the satin lining are those approved and authorized by the college or university from which the degree was earned.

Scholarship Pins

Students who received a scholarship from the UWL Foundation during their time at UWL are wearing pins on their gowns.

Medallion Symbolizes Academic Excellence

Wearing a medallion or seal of office has been a symbol of academic excellence since the Middle Ages. The seal marked official documents then; heads of institutions wore the seal around the neck to keep it in their possession. The chancellor's medallion features a design and materials that reflect UW-La Crosse. The mokume-gane or "wood grain metal" used is a specialty of the campus jewelry studio.

Mace Shows Quest for Truth

Once a weapon in medieval combat, the mace was adopted by universities as a symbol of the power of the quest for truth. The mace is carried in the commencement ceremony by a distinguished senior faculty member. William R. Fiorini, a UWL art professor, designed and made the medallion and mace, which were used for the first time at the inauguration of Chancellor Judith L. Kuipers in September 1992.


The mace and medallion were given to the University by Mary Hebberd and Ruth Nixon-Davy, professors emeriti. Silver plaques on the medallion box and mace stand acknowledge these gifts.

Symbols of Academic Achievement

Many undergraduate students are wearing items that reflect high academic achievement. Commencement Honors are designated by silver cords, and are worn by students who have at least a 3.50 cumulative grade point average. Those wearing gold cords have earned Commencement Highest Honors with at least a 3.75 average. Members of the Golden Key International Honour Society are wearing a medallion on a blue and gold neck ribbon. The organization is open to the top 15 percent of graduating seniors in various fields of study. Discipline-specific honor organizations are represented by a variety of other cords.

International Flags and Sashes

The international flags displayed on the commencement platform represent the home countries of international students attending the University. Sashes are worn by graduates who studied abroad. Each sash represents the country in which the student studied.



Even more reasons to be a proud UW-La Crosse graduate ...

- · UWL is the No. 2 public university of any size in Wisconsin, according to Forbes' 2023 America's Top Colleges list. Forbes noted UWL's array of academic concentrations and its active student body, as well as opportunities to engage with La Crosse's vibrant culture.
- UWL is the No. 1 public university in Wisconsin with fewer than 25,000 students, according to U.S. News & World Report. In its annual ranking of colleges and universities, U.S. News listed UWL as the No. 135 national public university in the country.
- UWL retained 86.5% for the 2022-23 first-year class the highest mark in a decade and the fifth-highest mark in the past 50 years. UWL's ability to recruit and retain students led to another year of increased enrollment, despite national declines in the number of college students.
- On July 1, incoming Chancellor James Beeby will become the 11th leader of UWL following a months-long national search. Beeby, currently the provost and vice president for Academic Affairs at Keene State College in New Hampshire, says he was struck by the reputation of the university and the dedication of the faculty, staff and students. He's been transitioning into his new role over the past two months and looks forward to hitting the ground running this summer. "During my visit to this beautiful campus, I was impressed with the dedication of the faculty and staff to student success and transforming lives through excellent academic programs," Beeby says. "I was also pleased to see the strong relationship with the city and local community, and I look forward to strengthening those ties as UW-La Crosse continues to serve the needs of the region and the state."
- Also on July 1, interim Chancellor Betsy Morgan will complete her service as interim chancellor and return to the role of provost. Morgan has led UWL through a challenging transitional period, leaning on her 30-plus years of experience at UWL to strengthen relationships and help move the university forward. Universities of Wisconsin President Jay Rothman thanked Morgan for her "wonderful presence," adding that "the campus community is indebted to her for her leadership."
- UWL's fourth-annual giving day, One Day for UWL, brought in more than \$475,000 from 1,900 donors in just 24 hours. The event was a success not just because it raised a record sum – but because it also raised awareness of the importance of philanthropy among the campus community.
- The UWL men's track and field team claimed its 20th NCAA Division III Indoor Championship in March - more than any other DIII program. The Eagles have now won back-to-back national championships, and a remarkable 13 in the past 20 years.
- La Crosse is the best small college town in Wisconsin and among the best in the country, according to Preply, an online language learning company. Its list of the best small college towns in the U.S. has La Crosse at No. 4 – the only Wisconsin city to crack the top 10.

- UWL is one of only 258 campuses in 38 states and the District of Columbia designated as a "Voter Friendly Campus." Voter Friendly Campuses help students overcome barriers to voting.
- Students get their money's worth at UWL according to a ranking by finance technology company SmartAsset. In the company's list of best value colleges, UWL placed No. 4 in Wisconsin and No. 50 in the U.S., underscoring UWL's commitment to affordability, high-quality academic programming and providing students with a strong return on their investment.
- · And, La Crosse is the state's most wallet-friendly and among the most economical college towns in the U.S. Scholarship and grant search engine BrokeScholar.com ranks La Crosse the No. 11 most economical college town in the U.S. and the No. 1 most economical place in Wisconsin for students to study.
- UWL is one of the most military friendly schools in the country. The 2023-24 Military Friendly Schools survey gave UWL the distinguished gold designation. Additionally, in the Military Times' ranking of the "Best for Vets," UWL was the No. 199 university in the U.S. and No. 35 in the Midwest.
- UWL Chemistry Professor Sujat Sen was named the 2023 Carl E. Gulbrandsen Innovator of the Year by WiSys, a state nonprofit organization that works with the UW System. The award is given to UW System faculty, staff or students who make exemplary contributions as a WiSvs innovator.
- UWL Health Professions Professor Tom Kernozek was one of 25 people named to Gov. Tony Evers' Task Force on the Healthcare Workforce. The group, led by Lt. Gov. Sara Rodriguez, is charged with studying the workforce challenges facing the state's health care system, identifying ways to improve patient care and alleviate burdens, exploring educational pathways to grow a sustainable workforce, and creating a solution-oriented action plan for consideration in the governor's 2025-27 executive budget.
- UWL has received national attention for some of its more than 20 graduate degree programs. U.S. News & World Report has recognized three graduate programs in the top 100 of their disciplines, including the UW MBA Consortium (No. 12), UWL's Doctorate of Physical Therapy program (No. 42) and UWL's Physician Assistant program (No. 65).
- A new partnership means full steam ahead for the UWL River Studies Center and water research. Prairie Springs: The Paul Fleckenstein Trust gave nearly \$500,000 through the La Crosse Community Foundation to fund the new research vessel. Local construction, environmental services, and harbor management company J.F. Brennan Co. will store, moor, and maintain the watercraft, which should hit the river this spring.

Baranowksi's thesis, "Foraging Ecology and Space Use of Breeding Flammulated Owls (*Psiloscops flammeolus*) in Northern Utah" required her to work many long nights obtaining bird movement data and investigating bird activity locations. Her diligence, according to Assistant Professor Markus Mika, allowed her to succeed in an area of research where others have failed. As a result, Baranowski's findings dramatically increase our understanding of habitat requirements for species living in dry mountain environments amid pressures caused by habitat loss, human disturbance from recreation, and climate change.
