- 2. Registration confirmation email from Register Blast system (see below).
- 3. Photo identification (valid driver's license, passport, or student ID card).
- 4. A non-programmable calculator, if desired, for the math test.

# How to register for the ACT Residual on REGISTER BLAST

Registration through REGISTER BLAST is required for the ACT Residual.

The registration deadline is one week before the test date (the Monday before the test).

You must register online; we no longer accept registrations by mail or walk in testing.

## How to Register:

- 1. Go to http://www.registerblast.com/uwlax
- 2. Once on the RegisterBlast page choose ACT Residual from the drop down list.
- 3. Choose a test date and fill in all the required fields. During check out you will enter your payment information, either a credit or debit card (MC or Visa). The exam fee for the ACT Residual is \$80. Register Blast charges a \$3.50 surcharge.
- 4. Keep your confirmation email as a receipt and bring it with you on the day of the exam.
- 5. You must have the front of this from signed by The Office of Admissions and bring it with you to your testing appointment.

You are responsible for taking the test on the date for which you register; once registered, payment is not refundable and test dates are not transferrable.
