You are required to take a college entrance exam as part of your application for admission to the University of Wisconsin La Crosse. An institutional version of the ACT exam – the Residual ACT - may be taken on the UWL campus, but scores are sent only to this campus. The Office of Admissions receives Residual ACT scores within two weeks after the test is taken. You must contact your admissions counselor to find out your scores from the Residual ACT. ACT will not send a copy of the scores to you.

You may also take the ACT on any National Testing Date. See the ACT website for more information on ACT National Test dates at: <http://www.act.org>

If you decide to take the ACT on a national test date, please be sure to send your scores to UW La Crosse (school code 4672) and allow eight weeks for the results to reach the Office of Admissions.

ACT is very strict in enforcing procedures relating to Residual ACT testing. UW La Crosse can only test current or prospective students. Residual ACT scores are sent only to the campus where the test was taken. If you plan to apply to another UW System campus, you must contact that campus directly for Residual ACT testing information. If you plan to apply to more than one college, you should take the ACT on a national test date.

To take the Residual ACT on the UW La Crosse campus, present this form signed by a UWL Admissions Counselor to the Testing Center in 2106 Centennial Hall. You are required to pre-register & pay the test fee using the Register Blast online registration system. You must show government issued photo identification, such as a driver's license or passport. Please read the instructions on the back of this form carefully.

If you take the Residual ACT, your scores will be sent to the Office of Admissions directly. If you have already taken the ACT exam on a National Test Date, please contact ACT and have your scores sent to the Office of Admissions (school code 4672, address below).

Take the test as soon as possible. If you previously took the Residual ACT, you must wait 60 days before retaking it, but you may take the National ACT during this period.

ATHLETES: If you plan to participate in intercollegiate athletics while attending the University of Wisconsin, you should immediately contact the intercollegiate athletic office (608/785-8616) regarding NCAA regulations governing testing.

1. This form, signed by an Admissions Counselor.
2. Registration confirmation email from Register Blast system (see below).
3. Photo identification (valid driver's license, passport, or student ID card).
4. A non-programmable calculator, if desired, for the math test.

How to register for the ACT Residual on REGISTER BLAST

Registration through REGISTER BLAST is required for the ACT Residual.

The registration deadline is one week before the test date (the Monday before the test).

You must register online; we no longer accept registrations by mail or walk in testing.

How to Register:

1. Go to <http://www.registerblast.com/uwlax>
2. Once on the RegisterBlast page choose ACT Residual from the drop down list.
3. Choose a test date and fill in all the required fields. During check out you will enter your payment information, either a credit or debit card (MC or Visa). The exam fee for the ACT Residual is \$80. Register Blast charges a \$3.50 surcharge.
4. Keep your confirmation email as a receipt and bring it with you on the day of the exam.
5. You must have the front of this form signed by The Office of Admissions and bring it with you to your testing appointment.

You are responsible for taking the test on the date for which you register; once registered, payment is not refundable and test dates are not transferrable.
