

A Progress Report to our Members on our Scholarship Efforts

As part of our mission, the Silver Eagles Endowment Scholarship Fund provides scholarships to UWL College of Business Administration (CBA) students as they prepare for their careers in business. We want to share with our members a progress report on funding scholarships for UWL CBA Students.

We are pleased to share with you that we have funded **55** scholarships totaling **\$53,550**. For a complete listing of scholarship recipients, the scholarships awarded and the timeframe of when the scholarships were awarded, please refer to the reverse side of this page. The Silver Eagles Endowment Scholarship Fund for the period ended **March 31, 2022** totaled **85,174.90**. There is also a separate endowed scholarship awarded by the Silver Eagles with a fund balance for the period ended **March 31, 2022** of **\$30,881.94**.

One thing has not changed. Wisconsin's state universities continue to become more expensive for students and UWL is no exception. Student debt continues to be on the rise and the financial burden of college is becoming a barrier to a growing number of students looking for a higher education.
