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

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Budget Terminology

2 CFR § 200.413 2 CFR § 200.414

Direct costs = costs that can be tied to a specific grant project.

- Personnel

- Fringe benefits
- Equipment
- SuppliesTravel
- Consultants

Indirect costs = real costs incurred by an institution but that cannot be tied to a specific grant project.

- Facilities & Administrative Costs (Federal)
- Administrative Costs (Foundation)
 Overhead (Corporate)

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A grantee must employ a full-time project director unless— (i) The director is also administering one or two additional programs for disadvantaged students operated by the sponsoring institution or agency; or (ii) The Secretary grants a waiver of this requirement. You may request funds under any of the categories listed as long as the item and amount are necessary to perform the proposed work, meet all the criteria for allowability under the applicable Federal cost principles, and are not prohibited by the funding restrictions in this FOA.



Such amounts may be used to release faculty members from normal duties for a specified amount of time not to exceed one course per quarter or semester.

As a general policy, NSF limits the salary compensation requested in the proposal budget for senior personnel to no more than two months of their regular salary in any one



For example, for summer REU Sites, many NSF units consider up to one month of salary for the PI, or distributed among the PI and other research mentors, to be appropriate for time spent administering and coordinating the REU Site, training mentors, and similar operational activities.



Salary support, including fringe benefits and indirect costs, is considered an eligible cost *only* for personnel directly involved in maintaining the instrument or providing appropriate technical support to operate the instrument.


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



Additionally, the MSP program funds cannot be spent on equipment (e.g., smart boards, computers, printers, camcorders).



In general, the WI Arts Board does not fund the following nor can the direct dollar for dollar match for Arts Board funs be used for these expenses: Capital equipment (items costing more than \$5,000 with a useful life of more than one year).



The WHC will not fund: Capital expenditures.














Cost Principles

 Is there a direct relationship between the item and the project?


Allowable


 Does the item/cost follow sponsor terms and conditions?

Are costs, at the institutional level, treated the same in like circumstances?
