Education Abroad/Away Programs

- **Total Students Abroad/Away:** 300+ students are expected to participate in a program abroad/away this academic year. Students are ready to travel the world and learn from others!
- **Popular Majors of Students Abroad/Away:** Management, Biology, Marketing, Global Cultures & Languages, and Psychology
- **Top Programs:** 60% of study abroad students participating in a faculty-led program
 - o 12 faculty-led programs will be offered this academic year
- **Destinations**: United Kingdom, Spain, Australia/New Zealand, Italy, Slovakia, Ecuador, France, Serbia and even Hawaii and California (National Student Exchange programs)

International Student Services

- Total Intl Students: 82 international students make UWL home this fall semester
- **Home Countries:** 26 countries are represented by our students including Nigeria, Germany, China, Malaysia, Japan, Italy, Kyrgyzstan, Ecuador, Bangladesh and more
- **Popular Program:** English as a Second Language (ESL), Data Science, Computer Engineering, Biology, Psychology, Marketing, Exercise Sports Science

UWL IEE continues to rebuild and grow since the pandemic. We are even anticipating a record number of students abroad over this next summer term (Summer 2023). Keep your fingers crossed for us! UWL is excited to welcome new international students and say good luck to our education abroad/away students. Adventure is the best way to learn!
