- 1) Introduction and recap of Workshop 2- Jack
 - a) Objectives
 - i) Update for the Bob Hetzel
 - ii) Review status of work / design w/ Executive Committee
 - iii) Confirm our track for next Workshop
 - b) Workshop 2 provided the following . . .
 - i) Clarity on quantity and quality of most all rooms
 - (1) Some first-time discussion between "roommates"
 - (2) Gave us understanding on their ability to collaborate & compromise
 - ii) Important discussion, and conclusion on room locations / space arrangements
 - iii) Knowledge that we have a concept costing less than \$40 M TPC
 - iv) Shared some 3D images as well, and had overall had positive response to both solutions



- c) Since Workshop 2
 - i) Vetting structural solutions
 - ii) Updating plan concepts
 - iii) Homing in on Site & Building Solutions
- Architectural Space Program & Probable Cost Summary
 - a) Based on Workshop 2 programmed area revisions and site assumptions in the spreadsheet the project is under the \$40 M TPC.
- 3) Program Space updates discussion
 - a) Considering a change to 20M radius, vs 21 on the Indoor Track based on User Group meeting input.
 - Before making a change, BH requested RDG to identify known Track Radii at existing fieldhouses in the Midwest, and convey that info to UWL so UWL can make an informed decision on the radius for their facility.
 - b) Reviewed all major space needs / (court layouts, as an example) and confirmed they will fit within the 20m and 21m configurations. 19m radius was eliminated as an option.
 - c) Both the 21m and 20m configurations are over the original 66,00 NSF program allocation (73,000 NSF and 71,100 NSF respectively).
 - d) Soccer Support Facilities
 - Water and Sanitary to these buildings? YES. Required per BH.
 - (1) Plumbing is desired for fully functional program spaces
 - ii) At Workshop 2 Users requested additional area for teams and a canopy for cover from weather. A different configuration for the Pressbox and filming was also requested. BH said the space as shown seemed excessive. The Pressbox and Filming areas were to be reduced.
 - Before proceeding with changes, BH requested a peer review of Soccer Facilities.
 - (1) Conference comparison, and aspirational institutions also.
- 4) Floor Plan Diagrams
 - e) Fieldhouse Venue differences
 - i) Spectator seating on centerline of venue
 - ii) Spectator seating aligned w/ Common Finish Line
 - f) Leveraging Mitchell Locker Rooms
 - i) Should baseball come over to the Fieldhouse? Should another sport(s) move, too?
 - (1) Athletic Director is looking at how to do this.
 - g) BH said additional locker rooms may be added to the project. Timing of any change in number is unknown. The design team should proceed with the current number of locker rooms until advised otherwise.
- 5) Design solutions
 - a) Liked the multiple design solutions
 - b) Leaning towards the more traditional forms and traditional elements
 - c) Option 1
 - i) Don't like the ultra-wide horizontal banding
 - ii) Look at Graff Main Hall. It is a highly regarded building on campus.
 - iii) Like the window profiles. Large is nice. Want a strong connection to the stadium area
 - iv) Align spectator seating with the Common Finish Line
 - v) Glass Garage Doors? Yes, but we need to consider the impact on HVAC systems, too.
 - vi) Use more stone banding like at Graff and Stadium? Consensus is yes.
 - vii) Desire for more grand entrance down into sports locker rooms
 - viii) Positive response to cardio platform overhang inside track for ESS equipment. Downside of a platform is that it may affect clearances with track (requiring the Fieldhouse to grow).

- 6) Site Design & Layout
 - a) New Soccer Support buildings are to replace other items shown in the buildable area now.
 - i) Most new construction will be west of the new Synthetic Turf
 - ii) It appears potable water is available nearby.
 - (1) North of outdoor track was thought to exist but needs to be verified.
 - (2) At City's Well Building potentially
 - b) Siting the Fieldhouse
 - i) How tight should we be to the existing outdoor track?
 - (1) Showing 50' from existing to FH, currently. May conflict with underground utilities.
 - ii) Action Item: UWL to provide existing grandstand layout used / planned at the Visitor Site of the Stadium
 - c) Exterior Entry Plaza to south of the facility
 - i) Drop off on Pine Street
 - ii) Initial Plaza design plays off running track (striping in plan, etc.)
 - iii) Screen for area near the City's Well House. Potential to be used as a feature wall or for displays.
- 7) Background from Bob Hetzel
 - a) Bob, Doug, VP Student Affairs, and AD all met yesterday
 - b) Make sure the design follows the program and not individual user "wants"
 - c) Driver for the Fieldhouse design is Indoor Track and Field
 - d) UWL has recently spent \$300k for Outdoor Spectator Seating at the Track and Field

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
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










FIELDHOUSE TRACK RADIUS OPTIONS



19M RADIUS- 71,900 NSF




20M RADIUS- 71,100 NSF






LEVEL 2 JOGGONG TRACK- 11,210 NSF



FIELDHOUSE BASEBALL/ SOFTBALL/ GOLF CAGES


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








SOCCER SUPPORT - SOCCER PRESS BOX AND TEAM BOXES







0 FLOOR PLAN - LEVEL 0 FLOOR PLANS
