Recreation Sports Meeting:

- 1) Brad Rodenburg, RDG, reviewed the Workshop agenda and gave a brief overview of Site Plan options (As presented at the Executive Meeting by Smith Group JJR.
- 2) Brad Rodenburg, RDG, reviewed the Floor Plans
 - a) Confirmed that showers have separate wet and dry areas divided by curtains
 - b) Divider curtain in multipurpose room is desired by rec sports to run two programs at the same time.
 - i) Mo noted Rec Sports could use multipurpose room for instructional exercises. She will work to provide the design team with potential activities housed within this room. This may drive floor finish selection.
 - c) One open storage space is good if there are lockable cabinets for secured storage
 - i) Provide 'cage and fencing' instead of wall and overhead door, to separate Rec Storage from Shared Storage.
 - d) Currently 6 BB at rec and 10 VB at rec
 - e) Sue noted that tennis and archery would be a priority.
 - i) Curtain at target end of archery needs to be durable and potentially transparent.
 - f) Discussed the possibility of turf on the infield of the track
 - i) Would lose opportunity to have basketball, volleyball and tennis this is ok with rec sports
 - ii) If turf does not work, then reduce to (2) basketball courts so there is more room between courts. 2'-0" (When divider curtain is down) is not acceptable.
 - y) Would consider losing one basketball court to increase distance between courts
 - i) Would not lower divider curtains between courts if they stay at 4' apart
 - h) Phenolic lockers for rec lockers
 - Equipment at cardio platform is only a place-holder right now and will need to be more defined.
- 3) Building exterior was reviewed by Hoang Tran, RDG.
- 4) Bob H. asked if construction scheduled can be shortened. Doug R. thinks realistically it can be cut from 22 months to 18 months. However, it would be difficult since construction in WI is dependent on seasons

- 5) Brad Rodenburg, RDG, reviewed the Workshop agenda and gave a brief overview of Site Plan options (As presented at the Executive Meeting by Smith Group JJR.
- 6) Brad Rodenburg, RDG, reviewed the Floor Plans
 - a) Design team to send SF of corners around track level, wish to locate strength equipment in these areas
 - i) Currently use 8 pieces in new rec facility.
 - ii) Potentially locate rowing machines, but weight training may be difficult in these areas.
 - b) Thinking 10 pieces of equipment would be used at cardio platform. UWL to provide specific list of equipment envisioned for this space.
 - c) Use mats for stretching and will need to store them in adjacent storage room
 - d) Mondo or wood floor could be used in multipurpose rooms, based on ESS use. They would use this space as one room for group warm up.
 - e) A/V desired for multipurpose rooms
 - f) Use one VB court, one pickleball court and area for group stretching. No basketball, as previously thought.
 - g) Would be fine with a turf infield
 - h) Pickleball could take place on RAF
- 7) Building exterior was reviewed by Hoang Tran, RDG.

- 8) Brad Rodenburg, RDG, reviewed the Workshop agenda and gave a brief overview of Site Plan options (As presented at the Executive Meeting by Smith Group JJR.
- 9) Brad Rodenburg reviewed the Floor Plans
 - a) All women's sports that have locker rooms in this project are spring sports
 - b) Athletes must shower before going to athletic training
 - i) Students that do not have to go to training may tend to go home w/o showering, especially softball that practices off-site.
 - c) More showers are desired at women's track and lacrosse
 - d) Separate showers/toilets for women's track and softball is not necessary
 - i) RDG will look into providing more showers but not separating.
 - e) Would prefer a RAF in multipurpose rooms. This would be better than wood.
 - i) Operable wall would be beneficial for large track meets
 - f) Should include golf hitting mats and lacrosse goal should be added to storage. Scott S. mentioned that some chair and table storage (Small quantity) would be nice. There is currently room in the plans.
 - i) Need to consider Golf and Lacrosse storage as well.
 - g) Will touch base with coaches to get reaction on infield turf
 - i) Kim mentioned that indoor throwing events aren't typically done on turf. RDG to look into this in more detail.
 - h) Leave sand pits together
 - i) Athletics will continue to work on sketches of field event layouts
 - i) Need to review the options presented with individual coaches.



- ii) Would be nice to be able to warm-up / utilize jogging track, with spikes. What is cost difference between Mondo Super X and Mondo

- k) What is life expectancy for RAF and indoor turf? RDG to send information to UWL on replacement of indoor turf, spikable surface, and indoor spike-resistant surface.




1 | Fieldhouse - Level 1 Floor Plan









1 | Fieldhouse - Level 2 Floor Plan - As seen





1 | Fieldhouse – Level 2 Floor Plan – Updated Progress




1 | Fieldhouse - Floor Plan




