# Academic Calendar Amendments 

University Individual Class Withdrawal Policy

## To begin in the 2021-22 calendar

Approved by Faculty Senate 12/10/2020
Any student may withdraw from a class until two weeks beyond mid-term of a full semester class. All withdrawals from classes after the "drop/add/change of schedule" period are recorded with a "W" on the student's permanent academic record along with the official date of withdrawal. (See the university drop/add/change of schedule policy for details on the add/drop/change of schedule period). Classes shorter than the full term length offered during a semester or during an intersession have withdrawal time limits established on a basis prorated to withdrawal dates for a full semester class.

The student must obtain either the advisor's or the instructor's permission during this time period. No student is permitted to withdraw from a class later than two weeks beyond mid-term of a semester for a full semester course. Only a grade of "F" or "I" may be recorded for any student who continues past this time period and fails to complete a class. See the withdrawal from UWL policy for exceptions.

Failure to follow the prescribed procedures and to observe the prescribed time limits for withdrawal from classes will result in the recording of failing grades in discontinued classes. If a student withdraws from a course taken as a "repeat," the original grade earned will remain in the overall grade point average calculation.

## University Drop/Add/Change of Schedule Policy

## To begin in the 2017-18 calendar

Approved by Faculty Senate 12/1/2016
The period of time between a student's initial registration for any term through the first 10 days of classes during an academic semester is considered to be the "drop/add/change of schedule" period. Classes shorter than the traditional full semester length offered during a semester or during an intersession have drop/add schedules that reflect deadlines pro-rated from a full semester based on the length of the class.

## Dropping a class

For schedule changes associated with dropping classes, neither the advisor's permission nor the instructor's permission is required during this period and a student may drop classes without affecting the permanent academic record. After the drop/add/change of schedule period, if a student withdraws from a course, the individual class withdrawal policy applies.

## Adding a class

For schedule changes associated with adding courses, if the desired section is not closed, no permissions are needed during the first five days of classes for full semester courses. From the sixth day through the tenth day of classes for full semester courses, permission from the instructor is required and departmental permission may also be required. After the close of the add/drop/change of schedule period, classes cannot be added except in unusual cases and then only with the consent of the instructor, department chair, and the dean's office.

## Academic Calendar Amendment

To begin in the 2015-16 calendar

Approved by Faculty Senate 3-27-2014
Every fall calendar has only 6 Mondays in the first 7 weeks but 8 Mondays in the second 7 weeks. For courses that only meet for the first half of the fall semester, this shorts them by one Monday. We are proposing to amend this calendar (and all calendars from this point forward) to move the date for mid-semester from Friday to the following Monday (for fall semesters only), making that Monday part of the first 7 weeks instead of part of the second 7 weeks. This also means the last day to drop a class would move from a Friday to the following Monday in the fall only. About 15 courses each fall would benefit from this change, and so far, we can see no disadvantage.

## REVISED SEVEN YEAR CYCLE CALENDAR PROPOSAL

## History of the current calendar

The seven year cycle calendar was approved by the Faculty Senate in 1989. Prior to the implementation of this calendar, fall and spring semesters sometimes differed by as much as three weeks, and were not consistent from one year to the next. The seven year cycle calendar was designed to correct this imbalance between the semesters, while still meeting requirements imposed by the legislature and UW-System. By state law, classes may not begin before September 2. By system policy, the contractual year consists of 39 weeks, and must include at least 34 weeks of organized activities for students, including classroom instruction, registration, advising and examinations.

The current calendar is based on the above restrictions and the following seven priorities.
Fall and spring semester should be the same length each year, as well as the same length from one year to the next, and should contain as many teaching days as possible consistent with other constraints.

Each semester should contain an equal number of Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. When necessary, days of the week will be renamed to achieve balance.

There should be as many four or five day weeks as possible.
The fall semester should start after Labor Day and end no later than December 22.
There should be 800 minutes of instructional time per credit hour, ( 770 minutes plus a final exam).
Each semester there should be approximately one week between the last final examination and the time grades are due.

Commencement should not conflict with any final examination times.
The seven year cycle calendar established a standard class length of fifty-five minutes, a uniform semester length of fourteen class weeks, one week of registration and orientation, and a two week period of final examinations and grading. We have used this calendar since the1991-92 school year.

## Proposed Revisions

This past fall, the Provost/Vice Chancellor charged the current ad hoc calendar committee to review a list of requests made by students, faculty, and administrators, and to recommend calendar adjustments as necessary.

After a thorough review of the requested adjustments, the committee decided that there were three academically sound changes that could be implemented while maintaining most of the priorities of the current calendar. By making these adjustments, most of the other requests were also accommodated.

There should be a break between the last day of classes and the first day of finals to allow students time to assimilate material from the end of the course.

Students, some faculty, and the Vice Chancellor/Provost all made this request. It was the top priority in a survey of students conducted by the Student Senate. For fall semester, the
committee recommends that the Thursday after classes end be designated as "Study Day" in six of the seven possible fall calendars, with finals beginning on Friday. In one year out of seven finals will begin on Thursday immediately after classes end in order to finish by December 22. For spring semester, the committee recommends that classes end on a Friday, so that finals can begin the following Monday. Although there will not be a designated Study Day in the spring, there will always be two days between the end of classes and the beginning of finals.

Commencement should be held after final examinations are over.
Students and some faculty made this request, but students assigned it a lower priority than Study Day. The committee recommends commencement after finals in the spring, but not in the fall.

There should be a uniform time period available for scheduling interim classes in January and May. The Registrar made this request. Interim classes constitute a small percentage of offerings at UW-L, so this request has the lowest priority. The committee feels that the issue of standards for interim courses needs to be reviewed.

Based on these requests, the committee recommends the following additional priorities for the calendar.
Whenever possible, there should be at least one day between the end of classes and the beginning of final examinations.

Whenever possible, commencement should follow final examinations, but should remain on a weekend.

There should be approximately three weeks in January and three weeks in May available for interim classes.

The calendars on pages $5-18$ were constructed by considering all of the above priorities. The basic structure is the same as the current calendar. The most notable changes are the following.

Classes will meet for three days during Thanksgiving week every year, rather than in one of seven years as in the current calendar. Every year during Thanksgiving week, Monday classes will meet on Monday, Thursday classes will meet on Tuesday and Friday classes will meet on Wednesday in order to achieve an equal number of each day of the week. The reason for this change is to make room for Study Day in the fall semester. The drawback is that in every fall there will be twelve weeks of classes with five days, one week of classes with four days, and two weeks of classes with three days. In the current calendar only one of the seven years follows this pattern.

Second semester classes will always start on the Monday following Martin Luther King, Jr. Day. In the current calendar this happens in four of seven years. The reason for this change is to eliminate the need to make up a Monday of classes later in the semester. Combined with the next proposed change, this allows classes to end on Friday, so finals can start on Monday. Another benefit is that there will always be approximately three weeks available for interim classes, starting after the first of January and ending before second semester classes start. The drawback is that in three of seven years, second semester will start a week later than in the current calendar.

Classes will be held on the Friday before Easter and the Monday after Easter. There are several reasons for this change. It eliminates the need to make up a Friday and a Monday of classes later
in the semester. It allows classes to end on a Friday, with finals starting the following Monday, giving students a two day period to prepare for finals. It allows finals to end on a Friday, so that commencement will be on a Saturday, immediately following finals. The drawbacks are that students will no longer have a "travel day" on the day after Easter, and students and faculty may have religious services to attend on Friday. Legally, students and faculty must be excused to attend services for any religious holiday, not just Christian holidays. The committee feels that it is appropriate for the university to treat all religious holidays equally. Currently, of the other thirteen UW schools, all but two hold classes on the Monday after Easter, and seven hold classes on the Friday before Easter.

## Recommendations

Adopt the revised Seven Year Cycle Calendar as presented on pages 5-18.

## Adopt the following Study Day Policy:

No final examination shall be given to any student on Study Day. Study Day is a day to prepare for the final examination period. No faculty or student activities of any sort shall be scheduled on Study Day. This includes make-up classes or tests, faculty or student committee meetings, and athletic practices or events.

## Recommendation for interim classes:

CAPS should establish standards for interim class offerings on the basis of the uniform time period made available in these calendars.

## SEVEN YEAR CYCLE CALENDAR PROPOSAL

This proposed calendar is intended to combine as many as possible of the best features of the various calendars proposed over the past two years. The priorities on which this calendar is based are:

1. Fall and spring semester should be the same length each year, as well as the same length from one year to the next, and should contain as many teaching days as possible consistent with other constraints.

This priority addresses the imbalance between the semesters which seems to be the source of much dissatisfaction with the current calendar.
2. Each semester should contain an equal number of Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays.

This balance is particularly important to classes which meet on a one day per week basis, but even M-W-F classes can be affected if too many Mondays or Fridays are missed during a semester. This priority is important enough that, when necessary, days of the week will be "renamed" to achieve balance.
3. There should be as many "full weeks" (4 or 5 day weeks) as possible.

Some laboratory courses cannot be adapted to a shorter week, causing loss of contact periods.
4. The fall semester should start after Labor Day and finals should end no later than December 22.

Starting after Labor Day allows our students to continue their summer employment through the weekend which is normally regarded as the end of the summer season and eliminates the possibility of having to change the calendar again if the legislature mandates that all UW-System schools start after Labor Day. Finishing fall semester finals before Christmas is preferred by the majority of both faculty and students as indicated on past surveys.
5. There should be at least 800 minutes of instructional time per credit hour (including final exams).

This number is based on the "traditional" 50 minutes per class $\times 16$ weeks $=800$ minutes per credit formula. Fall semesters have fallen well short of this number under the current system.

## 6. Each semester there should be approximately one week between the last final examination and the time

 grades are due.This priority allows ample time for grading essay finals, term papers and so forth. The current policy of requiring grades 48 hours after finals are over does not allow sufficient time for evaluating many types of work.

## 7. Commencement should not conflict with any scheduled final examination times.

The above objectives can all be achieved by extending the standard class period to 55 minutes (" X " classes to 85 minutes), and shortening the closure period by establishing a five day final examination period with no "study day". The resulting semesters will each have exactly 70 teaching days, 14 each of Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays. A three credit course meeting 3 times per week will have $14 \times 55=770$ minutes per credit of instructional time, and $770+40=810$ minutes per credit if a two-hour final examination is included. In order to exactly correspond to standard periods, " X " periods should be 82.5 minutes long, but this number has been rounded up to 85 minutes in order to be more convenient and maintain the desired minutes per credit ratio.

There will actually be seven different calendar patterns, depending on whether Labor Day falls on September 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7. In the pages that follow, we present these seven patterns both for ordinary years, and also for leap years. The dates for Easter are intentionally omitted from the text because Easter varies from one implementation to the next, but Easter is illustrated in the diagram as it will occur in the first use of that particular calendar pattern.

In addition to the calendars, the following are also included:

1. A revised daily class schedule.
2. A revised schedule for a five day final exam week.
3. A chart showing the dates for Easter and which calendar pattern to use for each of the next 30 years.

## EVENING EXAM SCHEDULE

1. As much as possible, exams will be scheduled on the regular meeting day of the week.
2. No exam will be scheduled on the night of the last day of closure period.

## NOTES TO FINAL EXAMINATION SCHEDULE

1. Classes which meet 4 or 5 days a week such as MTWTH or MTWTHF will use the MWF examination time and MW or WF "X" classes will also use the MWF examination time.
2. No student will be required to take more than three final exams on the same day. If a night class is not involved, instructors of the fourth and subsequent exams on that day will be obligated to reschedule that student's exam if the Registrar certifies that such an overload exists. If a night class is involved, the night class and the student's first two exams of the day will remain as scheduled and the other instructors will be obligated to reschedule their exams for that student.

## ROTATION OF EXAMINATION SCHEDULES

Evening exams will always be held at 7:00-9:00 in the evening on the days indicated in the "Evening Exam Schedule." In all other respects the examination schedule will be rotated according to the following two principles:

1. The daily schedule will rotate with days $\mathrm{A}, \mathrm{B}, \mathrm{C}, \mathrm{D}, \mathrm{E}$ in that order for the first closure period in which this schedule is used, days $\mathrm{B}, \mathrm{C}, \mathrm{D}, \mathrm{E}, \mathrm{A}$ in that order for the second closure period, days C, D, E, A, B the next time, and so on.
2. Internally, the times of day when the exams are held will also be rotated each semester. For example, here is the rotation for day A for the first three closure periods:
