Registration

All registration is done online via IMLeagues.

From the school's home page, click "March Madness" and enroll in either the Men's or Women's bracket pools (or both).

There are no team schedules.

Participants may sign up to fill out one bracket per tournament (i.e. one Men's and one Women's bracket).

To submit your entry, follow all instructions as provided by the website. All picks will be straight-up (simply pick a winner).

Your entry must be submitted on IMLeagues before the first round of games tip off. You will be able to change picks before each game online, depending on the website's rules.

When naming your entry online, please use your name as it appears in your IMLeagues profile.

Scoring

All scoring will be done via the online bracket provider selected. No scoring protests will be accepted.

Winning

The individual (men's and women's brackets) with the most points after the conclusion of the two tournaments shall be determined as the winner. Winners will receive a championship shirt.

In the event of a tie, the tiebreaker will be predicting the final score of the National Championship Game. The participant who picks the closest final score (as determined by the online bracket provider) will be the winner.
