

CPR/AED Review

Situation: A person starts to feel severe chest pains. A friend goes to get help. When they arrive back on the scene, the person (manikin) has collapsed and is lying motionless on the ground.

Witness (ERT member): Run to the staff member and explain your friend is having severe chest pain and needs help right away.

Checklist - (Facilitator will verbalize bold words in parenthesis):

___ Grab AED, first aid kit, radio and cell phone OR radio staff to bring these items to scene using correct radio language: “Attention, Attention, Attention: There is a Medical Emergency in (location) and (event details/resources needed)”*

___ Check the scene (**The scene is safe**)

___ Check the victim; tap shoulder and shout “are you okay, are you okay?” (**Victim does not respond**)

___ Do a 5-10-second check for breathing and other signs of life (**There are no signs of life**)*

___ Direct someone to call 911 and University Police*

___ Ensure bystanders or other staff open doors and meet EMS

If another staff member & AED are present, have that person prepare the AED while you perform CPR:

___ Begin CPR based on certification and continue until prompted by AED*

If another staff member is NOT yet available:

___ Begin CPR based on certification if waiting for AED to arrive on scene OR turn on AED and follow instructions*

___ Ensure no one and no objects are in contact with the person during AED analyzing and shocking*

___ Vocalize AED commands: (**Analyzing rhythm**) “stand clear” (**Shock advised**) “stand clear” (**Continue 5 cycles of CPR**)*

- CHECK, CALL, CARE, DOCUMENT, CHAIN OF COMMAND, CLEANUP & NEXT STEPS
