Fond du Lac Area Retired Educators 2022 Scholarship Cover Sheet

Since 1988, more than \$81,000 in scholarships has been awarded by the Fond du Lac Area Retired Education Association (FAREA) to deserving students who wish to pursue a career in the field of education. For 2022, FAREA is again offering scholarships to both public high school seniors and to university/college students.

Public high school seniors, residing in Fond du Lac County and who will be attending a university/college with a DPI accredited School of Education, are eligible for \$500 scholarships (minimum).

Any university/college student not yet accepted into a DPI accredited School of Education is also eligible to apply for a \$500 scholarship (minimum).
