

RESIDENCE HALL MOVE OUT: WASTE AND RECYCLING



Regular bagged household trash should continue to go in the green dumpsters as usual.



Comingled plastic, aluminum, glass and tin containers should continue to go in the blue dumpster for recycling as usual.



Paper and cardboard should continue to go in the white dumpster for recycling as usual. Please break down boxes before putting them into the dumpster.



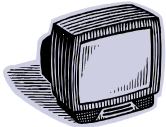
Furniture and Carpeting:

A large roll-off dumpster will be placed near each residence hall during the last 4 weeks of the semester. These roll-off dumpsters are for large bulky items such as furniture and carpeting. Please consider donating usable items to local charities before placing them in the roll-off dumpster. **Appliances, electronics and regular household trash should NOT be placed in the roll-off dumpsters.**

Metal Futon Frames:



Metal futon frames will be recycled if they are placed next to the roll-off dumpster. There will be a sign next to the roll-off designating a space to place metal futon frames. Futon mattresses should go into the roll-off dumpster.



Small Appliances and Electronics:

Televisions, microwaves, computer components, etc should be placed next to the roll-off dumpsters. These items are required by State Law to be recycled and should NOT go into the dumpsters. There will be signs next to each roll-off dumpster designating a space for small appliances and electronics. Facilities Maintenance staff will collect small appliances and electronics for recycling.



Lumber:

Lumber that is relatively clean and free of nails or screws can be placed next to the roll-off dumpsters. All lumber in reusable condition will be collected and given to local charities.



Clean Clothing and Non-Perishable Food:

There will be boxes in the lobby of each Residence Hall for the collection of clothing and non-perishable food items. All clothing must be **clean** and all food items must be **un-opened**. All food and clothing will be donated to the Salvation Army.
