

WHILE YOU ARE AWAITING PCR COVID TEST RESULTS

ON CAMPUS

- Check your results in your patient portal.
- Isolate in your current room/apartment.
 - You are only permitted to leave your room to collect meals or to use the restroom.
 - Masks should be worn at all times.
 - Disinfect surfaces after each use (countertops, door/sink handles, etc).
 - Maintain as much distance as you can with roommates.
- If there are concerns about isolating in your current room/apartment, you are encouraged to isolate away from campus.
- If you are unable to leave campus, call the COVID hotline at 608.785.8559, option 2 to discuss need for alternate housing.
 - If we are unable to answer please leave a message with name, phone #, reason for calling and we will call you back.
- Check your email for resources to assist you during your isolation.
- Answer your phone, even unknown numbers. Members of Residence Life and/or the Disease Investigation team may need to call you for more information.

OFF CAMPUS

- Please wait for an email containing direction to view your results in your patient portal.
- Weber will now only call patients that are positive via PCR testing.
- Separate from others in your home:
 - Stay in your own bedroom as much as possible.
 - Minimize time in shared areas.
 - If using shared areas, wear a mask.
 - Disinfect surfaces after each use (countertops, door/sink handles, etc.).
 - Do your own dishes and do not share food with others in your home.
 - Keep at least 6ft of distance between yourself and others in your home.

ISOLATION

- Do not have contact with others and stay home
- Do not go to class, work, sports, or other public activities
- Get rest and drink plenty of fluids. Over the counter medications such as ibuprofen or acetaminophen can be helpful. If you are concerned about your symptoms, contact the Student Health Center at 608.785.8558. Call 911 if you are experiencing a medical emergency.
