Donna Costa, DHS, OTR/L, FAOTA is an Associate Professor for the School of Occupational Therapy at Touro University Nevada. She has been an occupational therapist for over 40 years with experience in mental health practice and education. Donna's current research interest is in the efficacy of mindfulness-based interventions. She is a fellow of the American Occupational Therapy Association, has authored three books on fieldwork education for AOTA Press, has written numerous articles for *OT Practice*, and is the current Chair of the Special Interest Section Council for the American Occupational Therapy Association.

Donna will provide timely and important fieldwork education information aimed at increasing knowledge and skills in working with fieldwork students. The first part of the workshop will focus on working with students who are underperforming on fieldwork and identifying effective learning strategies to maximize their learning. The second part of the workshop will focus on the professional development of the fieldwork educator, identifying specific learning goals and resources that will increase participant's knowledge and skills related to fieldwork education.

Upon completion of the workshop, participants will be able to:

1. Identify effective learning strategies to use with students who are underperforming on fieldwork.
2. Establish a professional development plan specific to their role as a fieldwork educator.
